<b>Class Description:</b>	<b>2007 CBC Fundamentals Nonstructural Fire and life Safety Provisions</b> This is a two-day class that addresses the critical concepts of the CBC regarding nonstructural requirements. Provides a basis for the correct use of the code in building planning, fire-resistance-rated construction, fire protection systems and means of egress. Discusses issues that are the bases for many designs and plan review decisions. Upon completion of this seminar, participants will be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Locate general topic (chapters) in the 2006 CBC.</li> <li>2. Locate specific tables in the 2006 CBC for applicable situations.</li> <li>3. Identify code requirements applicable to real world situations.</li> <li>4. Discuss the intent behind a given code requirement.</li> <li>5. Interpret requirements for a scenario as compliant or noncompliant.</li> </ol>
<b>Certificate:</b>	Students will receive an ICC certificate and CEUs.
<b>Instructor:</b>	<b>Paul Armstrong, P.E.</b> is responsible for the development of the Building and Safety Service line in Southern California. Most of his career has been in the model code organizations in the development of codes and other technical services. His tasks have included secretariat to many of the previous ICBO code development committees and was secretariat of the ICC International Residential Code drafting committee and the ICC International Zoning Code drafting committee. He participates on many national and local committees and assists in state and local code adoption issues. He supervised the plan review services and Code Development staff at ICBO and was responsible for providing technical assistance to ICC membership, providing quick and accurate technical information through various media and upgrading the image of code enforcement officials, construction industry and ICC staff.
