**2007 California Fire Code Fundamentals
Hosted by the Santa Clara Fire Department**

Class Description:	<p>2007 CFC Fundamentals</p> <p>This is a one-day course that focuses on helping users that are familiar with the 2001 CFC adapt to the 2006 CFC. The information in this course details the differences between the two codes and covers concepts that are not in the 2001 CFC. Also, some of the codes in the UFC and CFC are the same, but located in different sections; this seminar covers this information as well.</p> <p>After completing this seminar, participants will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Identify the important differences between the 2006 CFC and the 2001 CFC. ▪ Identify information that has not changed in the two codes, but has been relocated. ▪ Identify and explain concepts that are in the 2006 CFC, but were absent from the 2001 CFC.

Instructor:	<p>Reinhard Hanselka is CEO and Principal Chemical Engineer for IES (Integrated Engineering Services) in Santa Clara, CA. He is former Fire Chief of the Palo Alto Fire Department.
